DIRECTIONS TO BURNHAM BEECHES GOLF CLUB

From Maidenhead

Take the A4 towards Slough. After the roundabout by Sainsbury's, continue towards Slough and at the first set of traffic lights turn left into Huntercombe Lane North. At mini roundabout at the top of the road turn right into Priory Road. Keep left and at second set of traffic lights turn left into Hogfair Lane. Keep to this road and at the end of a left hand bend, turn right into Britwell Road (signs for Burnham Beeches & Farnham Royal) and, almost immediately, turn left at crossroads into Green Lane. After Hazlehurst Road on left there is a narrow hill - please drive carefully. The entrance to the Club is then on your right.

From Slough

Take the A4 towards Maidenhead. Carry straight on at traffic lights by Greenoaks (Mercedes dealers) and keep going along A4 and straight across the large roundabout which goes to M4. Then at first set of traffic lights turn right into Huntercombe Lane North. At mini roundabout at the top of road turn right into Priory Road. Keep left and at second set of traffic lights turn left into Hogfair Lane. Keep to this road and at the end of a left hand bend turn right into Britwell Road (signs for Burnham Beeches & Farnham Royal) and at crossroads turn left into Green Lane. After Hazlehurst Road on left there is a narrow hill - please drive carefully. The entrance to the Club is then on your right.

From M4

Leave the motorway at Junction 7 for 'Slough West' and follow the Motorway spur until you meet the A4 at a large roundabout. Turn left here towards Maidenhead. At the first set of traffic lights turn right into Huntercombe Lane North. At mini roundabout at the top of road turn right into Priory Road. Keep left and at second set of traffic lights turn left into Hogfair Lane. Keep to this road and at the end of a left hand bend turn right into Britwell Road (signs for Burnham Beeches & Farnham Royal) and at crossroads turn left into Green Lane. After Hazlehurst Road on left there is a narrow hill - please drive carefully. The entrance to the Club is then on your right.

From M40

Leave the motorway at Junction 2 for Beaconsfield/Slough and follow signs to Slough and Farnham Royal via the A355. Go through Farnham Common and keep on the A355 until you reach the double mini-roundabouts at Farnham Royal. Turn right here for Burnham and follow the narrow lane until you reach a small roundabout. Fork right here and follow road until you reach a crossroads with a sign to Burnham Beeches & BBGC. Turn right here into Green Lane. After Hazlehurst Road on left the road narrows down a hill - please drive carefully. The entrance to the Club is then on your right.
